

Is there a Gay Agenda?

In the Bible there is a verse in Ephesians chapter four that says we should speak the truth in love. No, this does not mean we should go around telling every truth of our opinions that might hurt others. What I think it does mean is that we are to speak the truth when it needs to be heard, but it should be done in a loving way; not for the sake of hurting others, but for building up the body.

When you tell a loved one they have a problem in one area or another, maybe drinking or drugs or some other kind of addiction, you do it not to hurt them but because you love them. Christians believe the Bible is the truth from God and that it contains everything we need to know about living. Some refer to the BIBLE as Basic Instructions Before Leaving Earth and that's how a Christian should look at the Bible.

Homosexuality, normal and natural?

The Bible says that Homosexuality is a sin and before you think that it doesn't, let me point out several Bible verses. Leviticus 20:13-- "If there is a man who lies with a male as those who lie with a woman, both of them have committed a detestable act..." Romans 1:26-27-- "For this reason God gave them over to degrading passions; for their women exchanged the natural function for that which is unnatural, and in the same way also the men abandoned the natural function of the woman and burned in their desire toward one another, men with men committing indecent acts and receiving in their own persons the due penalty of their error." There is also First Corinthians 6:9, Leviticus 18:22, Genesis 19, First Timothy 1:9-10 and more.

So as Christians, we know that homosexuality is wrong. We also know that we should speak the truth in love. Does this mean yelling at people that they are sinners and going to Hell? This obviously skips over the love part. There are Christians who others do just that though and decide that the best way is to skip over the truth part, deny the truth of the Bible, or who create equivalency with other sins. While all sins are the same in the eyes of God, we must remember that doesn't make the sin acceptable. Different sins still have different consequences. Any and all sins keep us from God, that is why we need Jesus to save us. But no one who commits other sins can create a lifestyle of that sin and ignore what God says and just proclaim they were born that way. A Christian can't go around lying constantly and when called on it proclaim that he was born a liar and there is nothing he can do about it.

Science tried to tell us that there was a **gay** gene. Now they have come back and quietly said that there is **no gay** gene. The American Psychological Association put out a **brochure** that says, "There is no consensus among scientists about the exact reasons that an individual develops a heterosexual, bisexual, gay or lesbian orientation. Although much research has examined the possible genetic, hormonal, developmental, social, and cultural influences on sexual orientation, no findings have emerged that permit scientists to conclude that sexual orientation is determined by any particular factor or factors. Many think that nature and nurture both play complex roles...."

Why does it matter?

Homosexual activists have an agenda. It is **not gay marriage** or civil rights. What they want is to do whatever they want without being told that it's wrong. They want a society where their wildest fantasies can be indulged and no one will even think about judging them or their actions. If you know where to look and pay attention, it has been **documented** by the gay activists themselves that they don't want gay marriage or a traditional version of marriage for gays. What they want is to first convince society that gay sex is normal and then that any kind of sex is normal. Gay marriage is just the first step to accomplish that goal. They want us to think about the marriage, commitment and love, not the sex, at least at first. Once gay marriage is established, marriage between multiple partners comes next, and then sex between same gender or multiple people will be seen as normal with or without marriage. After all, society has seen and already acceptable sex outside of marriage for straight people. They will go even beyond that to then establish sex with animals and anything else they can imagine as normal and not up for debate..

Another prong of attack besides marriage is supposed civil rights. The right of all organizations to not hire or refuse gay people leadership positions, even in churches or religious organizations (**ENDA**) has already been made illegal in some states and a federal law is being worked on. They are now working on hate crimes laws that will impose extra penalties if a victim who has been attacked is gay and they can show that that's the reason for the attack. They say that it's about gays being targeted, but what about other groups being targeted? A law outlawing the crime should be enough. Extra laws based on a person's real or perceived identity doesn't make sense. The reason for this is that the next step is to outlaw saying that homosexuality is wrong. This has already happened in Canada.

The effects of the agenda

Whether you think it is exaggeration or not, the effects of this agenda may be nothing short than the destruction of marriage as an institution, the destruction of a moral society and **the end** of free speech.

I'm not saying that everyone who calls themselves gay is wholeheartedly part of this agenda, but that the homosexual movement is carefully orchestrated by several groups and a leadership that has certain goals.

As Christians we should not ignore this agenda and we should not let ourselves be used to further the agenda. Someone being gay isn't just about a sexual choice, it's about a lifestyle of sin. We need to speak the truth that homosexuality is a sin and that the lifestyle has personal and societal consequences. We need to speak the truth because we love others and don't want to see them trapped in a lifestyle that is a lie and keeps hurting those in it. We also need to speak the truth because those who propagate the agenda are hurting others.
