

Report: U.S. not ready for swine flu's possible comeback

The federal government is not prepared for a possible resurgence of the swine flu in the fall, according to a report from the Government Accountability Office. The report cited problems with how agencies will coordinate with each other, as well as ensuring the protection of federal workers and the availability of medical supplies.
